

# NEARLY-NEW YEAR RESOLUTION

BRF publish three sets of notes, all of which have their staunch supporters, but of which **New Daylight** is far and away the most popular. **New Daylight** is a 'stand-alone' in that the daily Bible passages are printed in the booklet, together with teaching, reflection and prayer for each day.

**Guidelines** offers in-depth Bible study - six passages per week, which can be read daily or as one extended study. **Day by Day with God** offers daily short readings with suggestions for longer Bible studies and is written by women for women.

All three sets of notes are written by a team of distinguished contributors who bring a wealth of experience from a wide range of Christian backgrounds.
